- Assist in implementing our flagship primary and secondary school education programmes, including:

 - **Content development:** research, draft and design workshop slides, handouts and assignments
 - **Workshop evaluation:** design workshop surveys to understand participants feedback and analyse results
 - **Reporting:** Draft and design a programme highlights report
